
WARNING:

Our L-400 light is rated for indoor/outdoor use. Please follow the safety practices stated in this manual, and use best safety practices to avoid any personal injury, fire or electrical shock. Some good safey practices to keep in mind:

- When using our lights in a wet location, a GFCI(Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) should be provided on outlets and circuits.
- Avoid using our light where water accumulates. Keep plugs dry.
- When using an extension cord, use only outdoor rated cords that are three prong outlet with ground.
 Please only use extension cords which are 18AWG or thicker.
- Do Not look directly at the bright light to avoid eye injuries.
- Do Not operate light near fammable liquid, material or surfaces.
- Do Not operate if any part of the light is broken.

Assembly Instructions



- 1. Loosen the screw on the (1) trolley, insert the (2) Two Stage Telescopic Mast, then tighten the screw on the (1) trolley.
- 2. Install the Light T-bar (3) of the lighting fixture into the (2) Two Stage Telescopic Mast, then tighten the T-Handle on the (4) T-bar.
- 3. Mount the (5) power supply box onto the (2) Two Stage Telescopic Mast. Loosen the four (6) M5 nuts, position the (7) bracket approximately 150 mm above the highest point of the (8) trolley, then re-tighten the four (6) M5 nuts to secure it.

Operation

- Plug into power supply and turn on the switch. (Use only 120V AC power)
- Rotate the (10) handle on the Two Stage Telescopic Mast clockwise to raise the mast.
- To lower the pole, rotate the (10) handle counterclockwise.
- When operating the trolley on a slope, make sure to engage the (11) brake.
- Use the (12) plug on the power box to connect additional lighting fixtures.
- Always switch off the light before unplugging the lighting fixture.



Warning: Risk of personal injury. To avoid being burned, always allow the work light to cool before handling.
